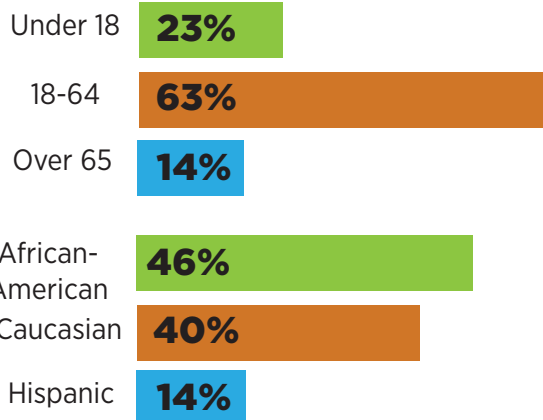


Moving Toward a Healthier Jasper County

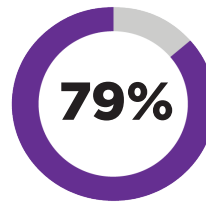

Jasper County Demographics

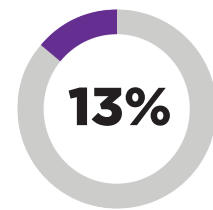

Jasper County Community Health Assessment Results

Jasper County leaders conducted a community health assessment to determine how residents feel about their health, their healthy eating and active living practices, and the areas in need of improvement.



What are the top five unhealthy behaviors?

1. Being Overweight
2. Drug Abuse
3. Poor Eating Habits
4. Lack of Exercise
5. Not Going to a Doctor



According to County Health Rankings, population health outcomes are as follows:

- 70%** Have Access to Physical Activity
- 26%** Are Physically Inactive
- 26%** Smoke
- 16%** Report Poor or Fair Health

Healthy School Environments

Access to Healthy Foods

Smoke-Free Communities⁹

Jasper County School District adopted a district-wide smoke-free and tobacco-free policy. This policy effects all employees and visitors at **100%** of its schools: **2** elementary schools, **1** middle school, and **1** high school.
